For HCV: What is your average case load per counselor?

Our average HCV caseload is between 525 and 550 per occupancy technician. The FSS and VASH coordinator have lower caseloads. Before you hit the roof, these are full service case workers and they are caught up on all recerts, interims and moves. (Dallas)

Pasadena - 350

Nacogdoches - 286

Our case load is divided by tasks (recert, portability, etc.) If it were divided by numbers, it would be 273 per specialist. (Longview)

Lamesa - 103

Cleburne - There are only 2 of us so approx 130 each!

Only have 101 vouchers. One employee manages the HCV and our 50 unit multi-family property. (Brenham)

Average HCV caseload is 350 - housing eligibility specialists complete initials, annual re-certifications, interims, moves for current clients and process terminations. (Austin)

Schertz - 153

Montgomery Co. - 215

Edinburg (970 vouchers) - We have 2 caseworkers, monthly **each** visits with an average of 35 annual re-exams and 20 interims. Supervisor takes care of move-ins, move outs and interims/re-exams when caseworkers are not available.

Paris - Average caseload; we have only one caseworker. The number varies from 250 to 290 vouchers.

Walker Co. - We have 251 vouchers and 1 counselor

Beeville - We have 245 average vouchers and two and half employees plus E.D. But at the end of March we will have to let one employee go.

Baird - one person, 55 -60

Eagle Pass - 220

Grand Prairie - Our average caseload is 386 HCV clients per Counselor

Denton - 350

Brazoria County - We try to average 270-280 per caseworker

DETCOG - Currently we have 4 workers @ average of 400/worker. Counselors do not perform eligibility nor interviews for re-exams - have two outreach staff working or assisting counselors.

Galveston - 265
