Did you have a gas meter system that you transferred over to a natural gas company?

We sold our gas lines to Center Point about three years ago. What a relief

Contacted Entex (now Centerpoint Energy) in about 2001 or 2002 to let them know we were abandoning our gas systems and switching to all-electric. We capped off connections inside the apts. and they took care of the rest. They d/c'd at the master meters and capped everything so that there would be no gas potentially flowing through our lines at all. (Kirbyville)

Yes, the Alto HA had a gas meter system that was transferred over to the City of Alto. This gas system was transferred to the city of Alto sometime in around 1990.

We have three master meters, which cause us to be under a small electric company and under the regulations of the Railroad Commission. We are working to convert to all electric. (Anson)

We had the Railroad Commission and transferred to Atmos (Elgin)

We do have natural gas meters, and the gas lines and meters are the property of the TX Gas utility co. (Austin)
