Texas Housing Association Scholarship Application College/University 2023

Who is Eligible?

- Applicant must be the child or dependent of an employee of a PHA in good membership standing.
- If the dependent is a step child, the employee must self-certify that the child completing the application is their dependent.
- Guardianship relationships will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- This scholarship is not for children of commissioners or residents.
- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior (within the time period August 2022 - June 2023 - includes early graduates within this school year).
- Applicant must be a U. S. Citizen.
- Applicant must have demonstrated excellence in the areas of academics, extracurricular school activities and community service.

How Much is the Scholarship?

Spring 2023, Texas Housing Association (THA) will be awarding 4 scholarships, each in the amount of \$4,000.

Winners are required to send a copy of their official acceptance letters to THA. Upon receipt, THA will send the funds directly to the applicable Financial Aid office for disbursement.

Application Package

- 1. Letter of introduction from the PHA executive director or the parent's immediate housing authority supervisor confirming the applicant's eligibility.
- 2. If the applicant is a step child of the PHA employee, a letter from the employee self-certifying the applicant is a dependent.
- 3. Completed application form
- 4. TYPED Essay describing how this scholarship will influence your future. Minimum of 500 words.
- 5. Three (3) letters of recommendation
 - a. one personal (someone who knows you outside of school and work)
 - b. two from community organizations, churches, supervisors and/or teachers
- 6. Letters from each organization for whom you performed community service during your four years of high school, indicating activity(ies) and number of hours volunteered.
- Certified transcript of grades INCLUDING FIRST HALF OF SENIOR YEAR or a letter from the school stating that this information is not yet available to the student.
- 8. The application asks for size of graduating class, class rank and ACT and/or SAT scores. THIS INFORMATION MUST BE INCLUDED or a letter from the school stating that this information is not yet available to the student.

How are the Applications Rated?

Applications are rated on a 100 point scale, as follows:

- application form: 15 points maximum
- essay: 25 points maximum
- recommendation letters: 10 points maximum
- grade point average: 15 points maximum
- ACT/SAT Score(s): 5 points maximum
- extracurricular activities and honors: 15 points maximum
- community service: 15 points maximum

PLEASE NOTE: APPLICATIONS WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE DISQUALIFIED IF:

- 1. Any of the required documents are missing
- 2. Emailed documents are not in the proper order and scanned as ONE file (individual emailed pdf files or individual documents mailed separately are not acceptable; do not have references send their letters directly to THA)
