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Yes, all of our elderly/disabled units (64+% of our total units) are shower- only.

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Yes. Several of our handicap units are shower only.

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All of our units have showers only.

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Yes, most of our 1 bedroom units are shower-only. We only have a few 1 bedroom units with a bath tub. \*\*\*

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accessible units only

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YES – 14 UNITS – 1 BEDROOM

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handicap units

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Yes, all one bedroom units.

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Only the family units have tubs, all zero and one bedrooms are shower-only.

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elderly units

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Yes, our two elderly apartments.

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Yes, our HI Rise Building units are all shower only, and some of our handicap units also have shower only.

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Yes, our elderly site has showers only plus four handicapped units are showers only and one two bedroom has shower only. When I remodeled 8 bathrooms in project 1 I wish I had done showers only because we do have requests for shower only by some applicants who do not necessarily qualify for elderly, disabled and handicapped units.

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Yes, our elderly units have only showers with seats in them.

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Yes, almost all of my 1-BR are showers only.

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Yes, we call those our handicap units.

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I have 24 shower-only units located in Elderly/Disabled units. Tenants love them because they were built with benches so they are able to sit and shower.

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12 one bedrooms that are shower only – 4 are ADA units

1 two bedroom – ADA units

1 three bedroom – ADA units

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Over half my units are shower only

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**We have 8 units that are shower only**

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In half of our one bedroom units only.

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Yes, some handicapped-accessible units have roll-in showers only.

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We have roll in shower units in our 2 3 bedroom handicap units.

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only the handicap have showers only.

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Yes 1 in a accessible unit and getting ready to change a tub to a shower 8in a 1 bedroom. Would not put one in a larger unit.

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IN ELDERLY UNITS-1 B/R

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Franklin Housing we are removing our tubs and replacing with large tile showers. We are putting tile on the complete bathroom at the same time. This makes for an updated look to the unit. Tenants in the one bedroom units are ok with this. Had one two bedroom unit that the mother with small children didn't care for it. Current tenant has two teenager and likes it. Have a 3 bedroom handicap unit that we are renovating and the scheduled tenant has requested that we make it a shower only.

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We have 12 of 20 that were built in 1965--all the single bedroom units are shower only.  
Then 8 of the 10 built in the 1970's  
Of the 20 built in the 80's only the handicap units are equipped with huge showers

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
