Alpine - This year the school and the city (so far, still need the Hospital and County) asked for a lot of information and wanted to know more of where the waiver money was going towards. The City gave us a THREE year waiver. I hope the others do a permanent waiver or something so we don't have to go before them annually? I had to jump the hoops and do the loops this time!

Lockhart Housing Authority is not receiving a PILOT waiver from either the City of Lockhart or LISD. However, Caldwell County has waived the PILOT.

New Boston – Yes for 3 years at a time.

Yoakum - Yes and No. We've always paid in the past, but got waiver last year from 3 of the 5 entities. Two told me they will waive indefinitely, one I have to submit yearly but they will waive. Two others (counties) I will have to pay, but we will request each year not to.

Lubbock - We go before City Council every year and request a waiver. They require documentation that we are doing capital improvements equal to or greater than PILOT.
